Dear Mayoral or City Council Candidate:

As a candidate for the Apache Junction City Council, certain legal obligations must be fulfilled in order to place your name in nomination on the ballot for the Primary Election which will be held Tuesday, August 4, 2020. As a candidate, it is your responsibility to meet these legal obligations.

For your convenience in filing for this nomination, the City Clerk's Department has assembled in this packet the necessary documents that are required by law. In order to ensure that your name is placed on the official ballot for the Primary Election, certain forms as contained in this packet must be completed and returned to my office no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday, April 6, 2020. **Note:** Even though city offices are open until 6:00 p.m., state law requires that your nomination papers be filed by 5.00 p.m. on the last date for filing. The Committee Campaign Finance Reports must be filed according to the deadlines indicated on each of the forms. Please contact my office in advance and schedule a time to submit your forms so that an election official is available and we can verify that your documentation is complete.
